

What We Do

Our mission is to make affordable 4G mobile, high-speed Internet service available to schools and nonprofits, so they can use this technology to better carry out their missions.

4G Mobile Access: This next-generation Internet service provides speeds that are up to four times faster than 3G, and has enough bandwidth to handle data-intensive applications like video streaming and other rich, multimedia content. Plus, our mobile service provides flexibility to expand learning outside classroom walls.

Low-Cost, Unlimited Data Plans: While other carriers often cap data usage and charge high overage fees, Mobile Beacon provides *unlimited* 4G mobile Internet access for one low fee of \$10/month, just a fraction of the monthly fees charged by other carriers.

Donation Programs: Knowing cost is often a barrier to upgrading technology, we partnered with Digital Wish to make up to 26 of our 4G devices available as a donation each year to public schools, 501(c)3 nonprofit schools, and libraries. See details at www.mobilebeacon.org/digitalwish.

Our 4G mobile Internet service helps schools:

- Integrate more technology in the classroom, including BYOD and 1-to-1 programs.
- Provide mobile access to teachers and staff so they can stay connected affordably from home, during off-campus events, and while traveling.
- Meet the broadband demands of the Common Core State Standards Initiative.
- Create a loaner program to provide out-of-school access to disadvantaged or at-risk students.

One of the greatest barriers to getting additional access is cost.

It's how we help schools get affordable access, so they can extend those benefits to students and staff both in and out of the classroom.
