4GX | Organizations who want to try one of our devices can apply for a single device through TechSoup's Donation Program. It's a great way to try our service and then decide if you would like additional devices.

Organizations may also apply for either the 4Gx10 or 4Gx25 program once during the same fiscal year (July 1 - June 30).

4G×10 This donation program provides nonprofits, schools, and libraries with up to ten 4G devices for connecting computers or WiFi-enabled consumer electronics like smartphones to our 4G mobile Internet service.

4G×25 In certain disaster recovery states (Colorado, Connecticut, New Jersey, New York, Oklahoma, Rhode Island and Texas), we have expanded the donation program to offer a total of 25 free devices to help nonprofits rebuild in the wake of natural disasters.

Affordable service

Internet service is not included with these donations, but is available for purchase at the current nonprofit pricing of \$120 for 12 months (\$10/month paid annually in advance).

Benefits for Organizations

Mobile Beacon's 4G service can help organizations that:

 Lack traditional Internet access, or suffer from slow connection speeds or bandwidth constraints.

· Have Internet service but need to provide users

- Need a back-up Internet source.

Nonprofit organizations can choose any combination of devices below for their selected donation program (4Gx1, 4Gx10, or 4Gx25).



CLEAR Stick Atlas

A portable USB modem for connecting one computer, laptop, or tablet PC to Mobile Beacon's 4G mobile broadband Internet service.



CLEAR Spot® Voyager

A portable, wireless hotspot for connecting up to eight WiFi-enabled computers or consumer electronics to Mobile Beacon's 4G mobile Internet service. The hotspot supports WiFi-enabled consumer electronics like tablet PCs, digital cameras, smartphones, printers, and Apple iOS devices.



CLEAR Hub Express

It's a modem with an integrated Wi-Fi router all in one! The CLEAR Hub Express gives you super fast 4G Internet for your organization. The integrated Wi-Fi router provides secure broadband connectivity and local networking. With this single device, you can connect up to ten Wi-Fi enabled consumer devices simultaneously while saving money, space, and the hassle of extra cords. Designed to work with Mac and PC.



Additional Devices Available at Standard Rates

Organizations can also purchase additional 4G devices directly from Mobile Beacon when applying for Mobile Beacon's services online at www.mobilebeacon.org. There is no limit on the number of devices that can be requested by qualified nonprofit and educational organizations.



Note: WiMAX-enabled devices can connect to Mobile Beacon's 4G service without a 4G device, but a service agreement is still required.

One Year Prepaid Service Agreement Required

Organizations that participate in this offer must agree to pay Mobile Beacon in advance for one year of 4G mobile broadband Internet service. The current nonprofit pricing for this service is \$120 for 12 months (\$10/month, paid annually in advance for each device). TechSoup is not a party to this agreement. Refunds for the service must be requested directly from Mobile Beacon within 30 days of receiving it. See Mobile Beacon's terms of service.

How to Apply

- Visit TechSoup at www.techsoup.org and select "Check Donation Eligibility" from the dropdown navigation to see if your organization is eligible for this offering.
- 2. Become a member of TechSoup and register your organization before requesting donations.
- 3. Once registered, select "Mobile Beacon" from the Product Donor dropdown menu and add the Mobile Beacon offering to your cart. There is an administrative fee payable to TechSoup to participate in these programs. Details at www.techsoup.org/mobile-beacon.
- 4. Once confirmation of eligibility is received, your nonprofit can apply for the requested donated 4G devices and service using Mobile Beacon's online grant application at www.mobilebeacon.org.

Verifying Coverage

Organizations must confirm that the location where they will use the 4G service falls within Mobile Beacon's 4G coverage area before requesting this offer.

Choose Carefully

The TechSoup administrative fee for the 4Gx1, 4Gx10, and 4Gx25 programs is not refundable, and the donation product cannot be exchanged.
